The 9th of May is an interesting date. For example: in 1788 the British Parliament abolished the slave trade. In 1865 The US President Andrew Johnson proclaimed the end if the American Civil War.

In 1916 the British-French Sykes-Picot conference over the division of Turkey began.

On the **9th of May** 1934, the corner stone was laid for the Hadassah University Hospital Mount Scopus was laid. It would open five years later. In 1945, the Hebrew University-Hadassah School of Medicine was opened



The Hadassah Medical Center (מרכז רפואי הדסה) was, as a medical organization established in 1934. It now that operates two university hospitals, at Ein Kerem and at Mount Scopus as well as schools of medicine, dentistry, nursing, and pharmacology affiliated with the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. Its declared mission is to extend a "hand to all, without regard for race, religion or ethnic origin



Hadassah's Symbol embodies four key elements:

- * The Star of David, the symbol of the Jewish people.
- * The Olive branches, symbolizing love and peace.
- * The Caption/Motto: Aruhat Bat

Ami, symbolizing the organization's goal ("The Healing of the Daughter of My People"). *Aruha* means healing, and the verse is taken from Jeremiah, 8:19-23.

* The Blue background, in the form of the English letter H, which begins the words Hospital and Health.

Hadassah's hospitals are under the auspices of the Hadassah Women's Organization of America. The organization was founded in New York, on March 3, 1912 by a group of women led by Henrietta Szold. After a visit to Israel, Ms. Szold devoted herself to the advancement of medical care in Israel. The first organizational meeting was held around the Purim holiday, inspiring the organization's name

Since the Hadassah organization was founded in New York, we will today, on the 9th of May, bring out our toast for the Rotary Club New York.
