R/ Mimi Boven is an American of Yemeni origin. She is married, and her husband is a U.S. diplomat currently assigned to the U.S. Consulate General in Jerusalem. They arrived in Jerusalem in May 2015 and will remain posted here until June 2019.



During her time in Jerusalem, Mimi has

been studying Hebrew and has developed relationships with local Israeli and Palestinian entrepreneurs. She is learning more about entrepreneurship at present with the goal of starting her own business in the future.

Prior to Jerusalem, Mimi and her husband were posted to Mumbai, India. There,she was responsible for community outreach at the U.S. Consulate General in Mumbai. 
