This Week's Program

Prof. Yehuda Bauer

"A Pesach Story - Refugees from Africa, Then and Now"



Professor Yehuda Bauer is Professor Emeritus of History and Holocaust Studies at the Avraham Harman Institute of Contemporary Jewry at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem and Academic Advisor to Yad Vashem. Bauer is fluent in Czech, Slovak, German, Hebrew, Yiddish, English, French, and Polish.

He was born in Prague, Czechoslovakia on 6 April 1926. His family migrated to Israel in 1939. After completing high school in Haifa, he attended Cardiff University in Wales on a British scholarship.

Upon returning to Israel, he joined Kibbutz Shoal and began his graduate studies at Hebrew University. He received his PhD in 1960 for a thesis on the British Mandate of Palestine. The following year, he began teaching at the Institute for Contemporary Jewry at The Hebrew University of Jerusalem. He was the founding editor of the Journal of Holocaust and Genocide Studies. Bauer has written numerous articles and books on the Holocaust and on Genocide. (See below)

In 1998, he was awarded the Israel Prize, the highest civilian award in Israel and in 2001 he was elected a member of the Israeli Academy of Science. Bauer has served as advisor to the Task Force for International Cooperation on Holocaust Education, Remembrance, and Research, and as senior advisor to the Swedish Government on the International Forum on Genocide Prevention.

On 28 March 28 1566 the foundation stone of La Vallette, Malta, was laid by Jean Parisot de La



Valette, a French nobleman and Grand Master of the Sovereign Military Order of Malta.

La Vallette is the capital of Malta and a piece of living history. With a collection of original Baroque architecture, fortified city walls, overlooking the Mediterranean Sea, and the spectacular Cathedral of St John.

The capital of Malta is linked to the history of the Order of St John of Jerusalem. Malta was ruled successively by the Phoenicians, Greeks, Carthaginians, Romans, Byzantines, Arabs and the Order of the Knights of St John. The city has been declared world heritage by UNESCO

Today we will toast the Rotary Club of La Vallette, chartered in April 2002. The Club has 54 members and is part of District 2110 (Sicily and Malta). The President for 2017-18 is Bryan Sullivan.

The Club meets every Thursday at 7.00 pm at The InterContinental Hotel, St. George's Bay.

The club supports a number of local and international service projects ranging from supporting a school in Tamil Nadu, India, for which a number of global grants have been obtained; and also annual projects chosen to support needy causes in Malta.

So for example the club has obtained district funds for a project for improving the home Suret il-Bniedem which houses homeless women, girls and children.

La Vallette was declared by UNESCO as European Capital City of Culture for 2018. The club provided UNESCO sign for the La Vallette entrance.




