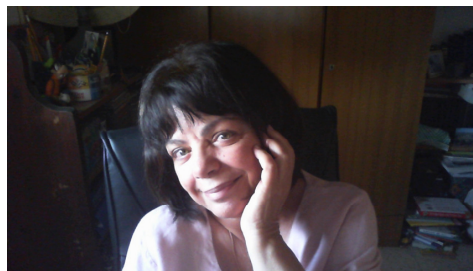

In addition to general city affairs. Peggy also covers the Haredi sector as well as the Arab sector in east Jerusalem. She also writes for Foreign Press, mostly in French.

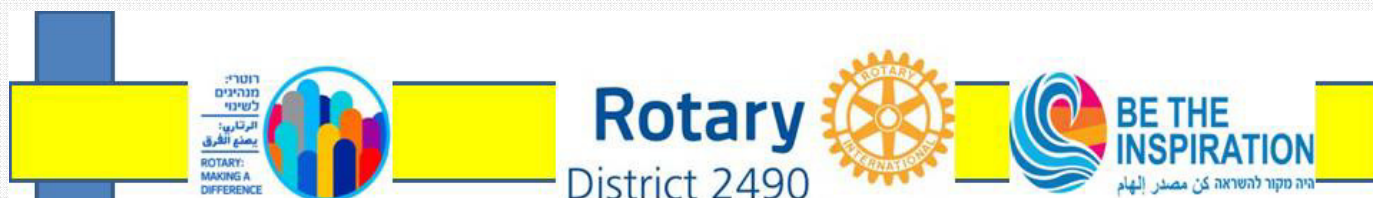
