We then need a couple of days to recuperate!


Many of our friends, are celebrating Easter or Pascha, with many festivities, which starting yesterday with Palm Sunday!



Undo the wrong, liberate women, bring in the seder-order we so long, and never, ever, pass a woman over again.






"Yahweh said, "I have surely seen the affliction of my people who are in Egypt, and have heard their cry..., for I know their sorrows." (Exodus 3:7)






Every row, column and mini-grid must contain the letters Easter. Don't guess - use logic

Celebrating the Exodus



ACROSS

- 3 Vegetables, which are dipped into salt water to represent the tears and pain of Jewish slaves in Egypt
- 4 Roasted egg, symbolizes mourning
- 6 Three matzohs; represent the unleavened bread the Jewish people took with them when they left Egypt
- 7 Bitter herbs; symbolizes bitterness of slavery

DOWN

- 1 Sweet, brown, pebbly mixture, representing the mortar used by Jewish slaves to build storehouses in Egypt
- 2 Bitter herbs; symbolizes bitterness of slavery
- 5 Roasted lamb shankbone: represents the korban or sacrificial


